

Gestures

A group speaking activity for elementary level Samoan to practise basic everyday expressions. 15 minutes. Cards needed

Instructions:

Organise the class into groups and hand out a set of cards to each group. The cards face down on the table. In turn, each student takes a card from the set, making sure the others cannot see it, and explains through gestures only the meaning of the sentence on the card. The rest of the group tries to guess that meaning, taking turns clockwise. The person who guesses right takes a new card and the game continues until the cards are finished.
